Sports Buildings

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Preamble

The following are eligible for these qualifications:

- the company which constructs the whole or a significant part of these works,
- the company which handles the contracts without performing the work itself but bearing technical and financial responsibility for the operation.

The company must have at least one engineer or one technician in the field of the requested qualification. Their know-how is certified by the person responsible for the Company. Expertise may be possessed by one or more employees of the Company.

Certificate of proficiency requirements

- (a) To be eligible for qualification, companies shall present certificates of proficiency concerning works dating from no more than **ten years**.**

The certificates of proficiency presented shall be valid for **five years**.

- (b) For qualification 200**

To be eligible for qualification, companies shall present certificates of proficiency concerning works dating from no more than **two years**.

The certificates of proficiency presented shall be valid for **two years**.

- (c) For qualification 250**

To be eligible for qualification, companies shall present certificates of proficiency concerning works dating from no more than **ten years**.

The certificates of proficiency presented shall be valid for **ten years**.

- (d) For qualifications 270 and 271**

To be eligible for qualification, companies shall present certificates of proficiency concerning works dating from no more than **two years**.

The certificates of proficiency presented shall be valid for **one year**.

Probationary qualification

Probationary qualification is awarded for a period of one (1) year; renewable once, for the same activity, to companies which do not yet have references or a sufficient number of references, provided that they meet the identification, legal, financial, human resource, equipment and insurance requirements as defined in the Qualification Award Standard.

An “*in situ* verification” procedure concerning human and material resources in particular will be triggered if the company has not reached the reference threshold defined in the sector standard (article 9 of the Internal Regulations).

Specific provisions

Only concerns companies located in Overseas Departments and Collectivities (Dom-Com).

Refer to the section entitled “Production of certificates of proficiency” and to the award standard (art. 3.5.2).

Qualifications

20 Sports Buildings

200 with Textile Covering

Building* enabling the practising of several sports in a school, competition, leisure or cultural context, based on canvas on a wooden or metal framework and included in the public sports buildings nomenclature.

Note: a certificate supplied by the company guarantees that the foundations meet the requirements of the DTU (*Unified Technical Documents*).

* The term "building" excludes temporary constructions. Such constructions may not be taken into consideration for qualification 200.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal (2) or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

Furthermore, the company must be insured for "decennial" liability.

Note: Sports Buildings with Textile Covering qualification (200) entails Supported or Stretched Canvas Structure qualification (271).

21 Sports Buildings without Terraces

210 Gymnasiums

Building without terraces enabling the practising of several sports in a school or competitive context.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal (2) or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

22 Halls

220 Omnisports

Building enabling the practising of several sports at national or international level.

Building enabling competitions, equipped with terraces able to accommodate at least 400 people.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(3)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

221 Specialised, primarily sports

Buildings of various dimensions and heights depending on their purpose and use, enabling practising of a sport: tennis – mini tennis - combat sports such as judo, jujitsu, kendo and associated disciplines, karate, taekwondo, related martial arts, wrestling - gymnastics, fencing - weightlifting - muscular training, body-building – bowling and skittle sports - shooting – table tennis.

Other sports : billiards, boxing, climbing, archery, trampolining and acrobatic sports.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(2)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

222 Multi-purpose, capacity ≤ 300

223 Multi-purpose, capacity > 300

Multifunctional building for sports, leisure and cultural use enabling the organising of cultural and leisure events and also the practising of sports at school level; building able to accommodate 300 people at most or more than 300 people.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(2)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

224 Auditoriums

Multi-purpose buildings enabling the organising and production of any show of a musical, theatrical or event type, etc.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(2)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

230 Media Libraries

Cultural facilities comprising convivial areas for familiarisation with cultural resources and new information technologies, accommodating the following: book library, video library, toy library, work rooms, multimedia, etc.

- Have internal **(3)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

240 ≤ 500 seats

Expertise and know-how

241 500 to 2000 seats

242 > 2000 seats

Building constructed by civil engineering comprising a concrete, wood and metal structure and built around an outdoor games area, with a capacity of 500 seats or less, or more than 2000 seats.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal (3) or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

250 Equestrian Centres

Facilities essentially intended for the practising and functioning of equestrian sports, comprising indoor rings, loose boxes, club houses, outdoor rings, etc. Such buildings are constructed in compliance with the standards in force.

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(2)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

26 Ancillary Sports Buildings

260 Dressing Rooms, Showers and Toilets

Independent buildings with a capacity proportional to the sports complex.

They are intended for undressing and storage of clothing; they are equipped with collective and individual showers/toilets and rooms for teachers and referees.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(2)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

270 Inflatable

Canvas-based construction systems enabling covering of a sports area, comprising a built-in blowing system and included in the indoor installations nomenclature.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(1)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

271 Supported or Stretched Canvas

Construction systems based on supported or stretched canvas enabling covering of sports areas and unroofed terraces, excluding temporary constructions.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(2)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

For the period of validity of the certificate of proficiency presented and the year of completion of the works, refer to the section entitled "Certificate of proficiency requirements".

28 Sports Buildings

280 Standard Renovation

Existing buildings or parts of buildings renovated without modification of the supporting structures.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(2)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

281 Complex Restructuring

Existing buildings or parts of buildings restructured with modification of the supporting structures.

Expertise and know-how

- Have work supervision, production and coordination personnel.
- Have internal **(3)** or external technical design resources appropriate for the qualification requested.

Production of certificates of proficiency

The applicant for qualification must produce a number of certificates of proficiency, signed by the Project Owner or Project Manager, concerning work in the activity concerned.

“Expertise & know-how” annotations

- (1) The company's technical design resources comprise at least one technician with two years of experience in the profession and the activity concerned. This person may be the head of the company.
- (2) The company's technical design resources comprise at least one engineer with two years of experience in the profession and the activity concerned. This person may be the head of the company.
- (3) The company's technical design resources must comprise at least two engineers with two years of experience in the profession and the activity concerned. One of these persons may be the head of the company.
